Identity Theft

Identity theft is the fastest growing crime in America, and Colorado ranks as the eleventh highest state for it. By definition, identity theft occurs when someone illegally uses one's personal and financial information to open credit card and other accounts, steal tax returns, apply for loans in that person's name, or draw down on a victim's line of credit. Although mostly associated with financial gain, stealing an individual's identity is also done to obtain benefits, such as public and private health insurance, or to gain employment using a victim's SSN. This presentation covers the types of identity theft, what to look for, how to protect yourself; and what to do if you become a victim.
